Fr. Mark writes: As part of our programme for adults wanting to receive sacraments or become Catholics we watched Bishop Robert Barron's video on who God truly is. It was challenging, overturning many assumptions. Bishop Barron's main point is that we can't control God nor force Him to act according to our assumptions. That can be a problem for the modern world where people want to control everything – even although logically we know we can't. James

and John in the Gospel want to be in control. Jesus has to remind them that they haven't understood His message if this is what they are asking. It is about service, not power. A message He lives out: 'the Son of Man Himself did not come to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.'

Catholic Primary School Applications

Fr. The parent/carer (who attends Mass here) should attend. Please bring the Certificate of Catholic Practice (one per school, having completed your child's details) and their baptism certificate (if the baptism did not take place here). There is **an appointment system**. To book an appointment, please <u>E-Mail</u> Lawrence, the catechist, at shepherdsbushcat@rcdow.org.uk indicating which of the three sessions you can attend. He will confirm the time. In seeking a reference, you are asking the priest to confirm you have attended Mass here each Sunday over a number of years. If you have recently moved into the parish or attend Mass more regularly elsewhere, it makes sense to seek a reference from that other parish.

Mass Count
