Third Sunday of Lent - Year C



Fr. Mark writes: The passage from the Book of Exodus seems at the start to be similar to other accounts of the gods in the religions of the ancient world: a miraculous revelation – a burning bush which is never burnt.

It quickly becomes apparent, however, that something very different is happening here. God identifies himself, not as one of the mythical gods of the ancient world, but as the God with whom Moses is already familiar: 'I am the God of your

fathers.' There is already a relationship. Moses knows who God is and can trust Him. He has shown a particular care for the people of Israel down the ages. And, so unlike the mythical gods of the ancient world, the one, true God is aware of the current sufferings of His people. He cares and He proposes to do something about it, working through Moses. He is revealed as a God of compassion – whom we come to know fully in the Person of Jesus Christ.
