Assisted Suicide

As the Cardinal said in his Pastoral Letter there is profound unease about this proposal – not only that vulnerable people will come under pressure to end their lives, but also that the normal scrutiny is not being given to such a momentous proposal. The promised safeguards are already being withdrawn. This is deeply disturbing. The crucial Third Reading in the House of Commons is on **25 April**. The Bishops urge us to contact our MPs requesting them to vote against the Bill. The Hammersmith & Chiswick MP is Andy Slaughter: andy@andyslaughter.com The Ealing Central & Acton MP is Rupa Huq: rupa.huq.mp@parliament.uk Rupa Huq changed her mind and voted against the proposal last time round. Andy Slaughter is still saying he intends to vote for it. In writing to your MP, you may find it helpful to take a copy of the Cardinal's Pastoral Letter, which I have left at the back of church. Please pray that this ill-considered and dangerous proposal is defeated.
